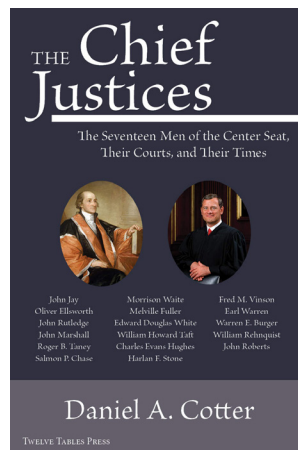


Join us for a discussion of the third branch of government and the role the U.S. Supreme Court has played in our American heritage as we celebrate Constitution Day at KCC.
