## financial aid

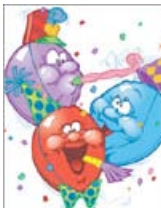
Effective Aug. 3, students receiving financial aid for Fall 2009 may purchase books, supplies and clothing in the KCC Hammes Bookstore.
