Continuing a winning tradition

With three teams finishing in the top five in the nation last season, 2008-09 was another year for Cavaliers fans to be proud of.

The baseball team finished third in the NJCAA Division II World Series in Enid, Okla., with a record of 52-14-1. In its history, the team has 20 professional players, 14 All-Americans and seven Academic All-Americans.

The softball team finished with a 46-11 record, and finished in fourth place at the NJCAA Division II National Tournament in Normal. The Cavaliers have now been to the national tournament 11 years in a row, and 14 times in the last 16 years.

The women's basketball team finished fifth at the NJCAA Division II National Tournament in Peoria. The team finished with a 28-7 record. Women's basketball has participated in the national tournament 16 times in the last 20 years, and has been national champion once and runner-up four times.

KCC's volleyball and men's basketball teams also enjoyed winning seasons last year.

The volleyball team ended the 2008 season with a 36-13 record. The team has won the Region IV championship 13 times in the last 22 years and has made 12 national tournament appearances. The men's basketball team finished the 2008-09 season with a 27-7 record. The men's basketball team has participated in the National "Sweet 16" six times advancing to the Final Four in 2000 and the National Championship game in 1985 and 1988.

KCC's soccer team continues to build its program around local, non-scholarship athletes. After three seasons, the team is still seeking its first winning season.
