Health Careers HESI A2 Testing Information Helpful information for Spring 2020

Beginning March 18, 2020, KCC facilities closed temporarily in an effort to reduce potential pathways for community spread of coronavirus (COVID-19). Current college statuses can be found at coronavirus.kcc.edu.

Until KCC facilities re-open, the Health Careers Division is postponing the completion of applications to its programs and postponing health careers eligibility appeals.

Acceptance process

A score of 75% or higher is required to be considered for ranking for the RN and RN Advanced Placement programs. For other competitive entry Health Career programs, a score of 70% or higher is required to be considered for ranking.

Scores will be loaded into the database and ranked after the testing deadline. A letter will be emailed to your KCC student email notifying you of your status. No information will be disclosed regarding scores or ranking besides the notification letter you receive.

You are allowed to apply to one Health Career program per calendar year with the exception of Nursing, where you are allowed to apply for two if you so choose (PN, RN, RN Advanced Placement).
