

## KCC's Online Catalog

KCC's Online Catalog is the name of KCC's portion of the online catalog database used by the 71 members of the I-Share group of the CARLI consortium. Members of the consortium include KCC, Olivet Nazarene, Joliet Junior College, Governor's State University, University of Illinois, Southern Illinois, Illinois State University, Western Illinois and Eastern Illinois. Your KCC id is valid at all locations.

The "I-Share Catalog" is a database which contains a list of materials owned by the KCC Learning Resource Center, as well as the collections at 70 other libraries in Illinois. The collections can be searched collectively or individually.

**Start** by going to [www.kcc.edu](http://www.kcc.edu). Use the "Library" link under "Resources" to go to the Library. Then select **Find Books and More**.

The most common ways to search are by author, title or subject searches. Remember to put the author's last name first when searching for an author. Keyword searching is also heavily used. **SEARCH FOR** defaults to a keyword search.

**Quick limits** allow the selection of type of material (book, video, etc.), most recent publication years and other useful features.

### KEYWORD and SUBJECT searching

You can usually find better books faster by using the **Advanced Search** screen. A SUBJECT or TITLE Word search would provide a more specific way of accessing information. Another option would be to use the keyword search along with 'all of these' or 'as a phrase'. Select a good book on your topic. Look at the detailed screen for the 'subject headings'. The headings can be selected to find more books on the same topic.

The three screen shots below illustrate what a typical subject search in the Advanced Search screen look like, along with subject headings in the results.

The catalog provides an item's **title**, **author**, **call number**, the **location** within the library. A *call number* is a unique combination of letters and numbers, which identify where a physical item is located on the library shelves. The call number contains a series of letters and numbers before a decimal (.) and a series of letters and numbers after a decimal. The letters and numbers before the decimal indicate a subject. The letters and numbers after the decimal indicate the author and, sometimes, the year of publication.

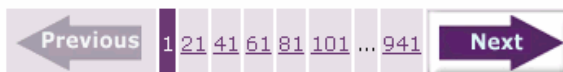
**To Request an Interlibrary Loan book from KCC's Online Catalog:**

3. When a single title is on your screen (by selecting the title or line number), press the *Request* button and the screen (below) will appear.
4. Change \*Please Select Library\* to 'Kankakee Community College'
5. "Library Borrower ID" is the 14-digit barcode which begins with 20911 and is found on your KCC Photo id.
6. Type in your last name.
7. Press Login.

## Patron Login

### For users:

Please select your home library, enter your Library Borrower ID and Last Name, then click the Login button. If you have a 14-digit ID, it may be printed near the barcode on your library ID Card. A 9-digit ID may be the same as your Social Security number.

### For staff at ILLINET member libraries and Library System Headquarters:

Select "ILLINET Libraries" as your home library, and enter "illinet" or "system" as your last name. Your borrower ID is the same nine-digit number you used in the past.

10. On the confirmation screen (shown below), re-type your 14-digit barcode in 'Library Borrower ID'.

12. Submit the request.
